

What to Bring

- Bible, notepad, pens, pencils
- Sleeping bag and pillow (stuffed animal is optional)
- At least eight (8) sets of clothing for warm or cold weather according to the dress code.
- A bag for dirty clothes.
- Shoes. You must bring a pair of Tennis shoes. No open toe shoes during activities times and no bare feet any time outside the cabin.
- At least two towels plus one for the pool.
- Toiletries (shampoo, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb/brush, sunscreen, and **deodorant**).
- Spending money ... Most campers bring about \$30.00
 - (All money must be deposited into the camp bank, or use the website to deposit money via PayPal.)
- Stamps if you plan to write home.
- A big smile and a great attitude!
- Decorations for your room (optional).
- Flashlight (optional).

What **NOT** to bring

- **Cell phone**, radios, CD players, i-pods, game systems, electronic Bibles or any other electronic devices
- Guns or Squirt guns
- Weapons (including pocket knives)
- Poor attitudes
- Inappropriate literature
